The Florida State Fair is sponsoring a Grant to an exhibitor in each of the Youth Breeding Shows. The Grant will give an exhibitor designated funds towards the purchase of a registered animal (Beef - \$400; Dairy - \$400; Dairy Goat - \$250; Boer Goat - \$250; Poultry - \$50; Rabbit - \$50; and Sheep - \$250). The grant is available to a 2022 Florida State Fair Youth Livestock exhibitor 14 years old and younger (as of Sept. 1, 2022). Exhibitors are only eligible to apply for a grant within the specie they are showing. Exhibitors are only eligible to enter and win this Grant one time. Applications will be reviewed by a committee appointed by the Superintendent of each show and a winner will be selected. If deemed necessary, finalists will be selected for an interview.

To be considered for this Grant, individuals must apply by December 3, 2021. (POSTMARK) Application Packet must include:

- 1) Application form completely filled out. (Hand Written)
- Handwritten Essay (125-150 words) titled "Why I would like to purchase a Registered Animal".
   One letter of recommendation from any of the following: 4-H Club or FFA Advisor, County Extension Director, Vocational Agriculture Teacher, Junior Breed Association Advisor.
