#### **RULES**

- 1. FFA Chapters or 4-H Clubs must pre-enter by December 3, 2021.
- 2. All entries must submit a sketch/diagram of decoration and theme.
- 3. Chapters/Clubs will be notified by email if they have been selected to participate by December 17th.
- 4. The Florida State Fair will provide a round bale for each participating Chapter/Club to decorate.
- 5. Entries will be judged on eye appeal, construction, use of materials, and creativity.
- 6. Hay bales may be decorated February 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup>. Entries will be judged Thursday, February 10, 2022. The bales should be decorated with a good clean wholesome nature. No vulgar or suggestive decorations will be allowed this includes people rolled up inside a bale with feet or head sticking out. Please call the Florida State Fair office with any questions (813) 621-7821.
- 7. Bales can be placed lying on their side or standing on end. This will be your choice. Please specify position of bale on entry form. If you will be providing a maximum of 8 small rectangular bales for feet or decoration please list on entry form. For safety purposes round bales will **not** be stacked on top of each other. Also, please note that not all the hay bale locations are on grass, some will be displayed on concrete.
- 8. Decorations should be weather and wind-proof.
- 9. Paint may be applied to the hay bale or grass.
- 10. NO Commercial or Political party signs of ANY KIND are allowed.
- 11. Decorations may not be removed from bales before Monday, February 21<sup>st</sup> at 9:00 p.m. Decorations need to be removed from bales by 9 a.m. on Tuesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>. Decorations not removed on Tuesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> will be discarded.
- 12. The management of the Florida State Fair reserves the right to revise the dollar amount of the Premiums.
