Students are divided into groups marked by brightly colored cowboy hats, and each group visits five stations representing different aspects of agriculture. Students can participate in a variety of hands-on activities, including beef and dairy animal stations and watermelon or strawberry crop stations. These stations vary from year to year to keep the program engaging.



READY TO REGISTER?
