1. All animals must be registered with either the American Dexter Cattle Association or the Purebred Dexter Cattle Association. Tattoos must be legible and must match registration papers.

2. Original registration papers must accompany all animals.

3. Exhibitors must be able to handle their animal in the show ring and on show grounds

4. ALL Bulls born before September 1, 2022, will have a properly affixed Bull ring in their noses for the entire time they are on the fairgrounds. The ring can be permanent or the removable type.

*Cow/Calf does not compete for overall champion female.
