1. Fall Heifer Calf born September 1 - November 30, 2023 (animals must be weaned)
2. Summer Heifer Calf, born June 1 - August 31, 2023
3. Spring Heifer Calf born March 1 - May 31, 2023
4. Winter Yearling Heifer born December 1, 2022 - February 28, 2023
5. Fall Yearling Heifer born September 1 - November 30, 2022
6. Summer Yearling Heifer born June 1 - August 31, 2022
7. Spring Yearling Heifer born March 1 - May 30, 2022 (any yearling in milk will be shown in two-year-old class)
8. **JUNIOR CHAMPION**
9. **RESERVE JUNIOR CHAMPION**
10. Junior Two-year-old cow born September 1, 2021 - February 28, 2022
11. Senior Two-year-old cow born March 1, 2021 - August 31, 2021
12. Three-year-old cow born March 1, 2020 - February 29, 2021
13. Four-year-old cow born March 1, 2019 - February 28, 2020
14. Five-year-old cow born March 1, 2018 - February 29, 2019
15. Aged cow born before March 1, 2018
16. Dry Cow Class - any animal born before September 1, 2018, that has had one or more lactations and is currently dry.
17. **SENIOR CHAMPION**
18. **RESERVE SENIOR CHAMPION**
19. **GRAND CHAMPION**
20. **RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION**

21. Dairy Herd, four cows, all that have freshened. All are to be owned by exhibitor limited to one entry
22. Best three senior females, any animal from class 10 - 15, all are to have been bred by and at least one animal currently owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.
23. Best three junior females, any animal from class 1 - 7, all are to have been bred by and at least one animal currently owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.
24. Produce-of-Dam, two animals any age the produce of one cow. Animals need not be owned by one exhibitor.
25. Daughter-Dam, 2 animals, dam and daughter, any age. Animals need not be owned by one exhibitor.
26. Breeders Herd, five females, all owned by the exhibitor, consists of two females over two years of age, two females uncalfed under two years of age and one of any age. Three must be bred by the exhibitor.
27. Best Udder Awards, prior to final placing of cows in classes 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15.  
The judge will select the first and second best uddered cows in each of these classes. Selection will be made on the basis of udder alone with milkout left to the discretion of the judge. Class winners will not compete against each other for best uddered cow of the show.

**Supreme Champion to be judged Monday, February 19<sup>th</sup> the end of the show.**
