

# YOUTH BRANGUS SHOW CLASSES

## SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

### Show Eligibility and Inspection of Exhibits

1. Animals must be purebred and registered in the International Brangus Breeders Association (IBBA) to be eligible to compete in the Association sponsored show. Both Red and Black Brangus are eligible to show.
2. Animals recorded in the appendix registry are disqualified.
3. The IBBA, and its representatives, have the authority to require such tests as they deem necessary to verify the accuracy of the classifications and pedigree of exhibited Brangus animals. Said authority shall extend to, and cover the enforcement of, all show rules as adopted by the IBBA.
4. Prior to check-in, heads of heifers must be clipped of all hair (including topknots) and be free of scurs and/or slick spots.
5. Any animal found to have scurs and/or slick spots or evidence of incisions, surgical or otherwise, in the following areas: head, navel or dewlap, will be disqualified from showing. Animals with illegal white (white in front of the navel) or any indication of brindling (a color pattern characterized by red streaks mingled with black) are ineligible to show at the Florida State Fair.
6. All bulls (shown as an individual entry) must be shown with a nose ring or nose restraint with lead attached.
7. All Brangus entries are subject to the provisions of a rule of the International Brangus Breeders Association entitled "Inspection of Exhibits," which can be found at [gobrangus.com/shows](http://gobrangus.com/shows).
8. Any animal upon check-in which does not have a legible tattoo or brand corresponding to its registration certificate is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible tattoo/brand, animals cannot be re-tattooed and rechecked at the Show. The tattoo/brand can be rechecked at the next available show.

### Bred & Owned Division (B&O) sponsored by the Florida Junior Brangus Breeders Association:



1. Exhibitors must enter their animal as a Bred and Owned at time of entry to be eligible to compete in that division (Classes 62 & 63). This division will only include heifers and bulls (no cow-calf pairs). The highest ranking Bred & Owned animal from each class or division will be eligible to come back for the Grand Supreme Drive of Black Brangus, Red Brangus and Ultra Brangus.
2. A Grand & Reserve Supreme B&O Champion will be awarded and placed from the Black Brangus, Red Brangus and Ultra Brangus divisions in both the heifer and bull shows.
3. Bred and owned animal classes shall be limited to animals both owned and bred solely by the junior exhibitor. The junior exhibitor must be the sole breeder, and first and continuous owner of the animal entered. "Breeder" is defined as the sole owner of record of the dam at the time of service based off the transfer timestamp date. "First owner" is defined as the sole owner of record of the dam at the time the calf is born. The Junior exhibitor must be the only (sole) recorded owner of the dam with IBBA (according to the IBBA registry system's timestamp) from conception to birth and the only recorded owner of the animal from birth to show day. Recorded owner is defined by the timestamp of when the transfer was completed within the IBBA registry system. A partial interest of a bred and owned bull may be sold as long as he remains in the exhibitor's care and possession throughout show career.
4. Points will be tabulated for animals and kept accordingly, using their tattoo brand.
5. If a protest is made about the validity of the animal being a bred & owned, we will contact the exhibitor/family. If proof is provided that the animal is NOT in fact a Bred & Owned (i.e. – pictures, sale catalogs, proof of purchase) then the animal will be disqualified from the B&O division and all remaining B&O divisions in the FJBBA Point series. The exhibitor will forfeit their right to enter a Bred & Owned animal at ANY future FJBBA point shows.
6. The FJBBA will check with the International Brangus Breeders Association that cattle that are entered are Bred & Owned, to ensure the breeder and owner have not changed since initial registration papers were filed (Timestamp information). Once an animal's registration information changes, Bred & Owned status becomes null and void.
