- **21.** Dairy Herd, four cows, all that have freshened. All are to be owned by exhibitor limited to one entry
- 22. Best three senior females, any animal from class 10 15, all are to have been bred by and at least one animal currently owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.
- 23. Best three junior females, any animal from class 1 7, all are to have been bred by and at least one animal currently owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.
- **24.** Produce-of-Dam, two animals any age the produce of one cow. Animals need not be owned by one exhibitor.
- **25.** Daughter-Dam, 2 animals, dam and daughter, any age. Animals need not be owned by one exhibitor.
- 26. Breeders Herd, five females, all owned by the exhibitor, consists of two females over two years of age, two females uncalved under two years of age and one of any age. Three must be bred by the exhibitor.
- 27. Best Udder Awards, prior to final placing of cows in classes 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15.

 The judge will select the first and second best uddered cows in each of these classes. Selection will be made on the basis of udder alone with milkout left to the discretion of the judge. Class winners will not compete against each other for best uddered cow of the show.
